

Rustic DNOW Health and Hygiene Guidelines

As we are preparing to take your teenagers to DNOW, we want to do what we can to protect everyone. We have formed a Health and Hygiene team whose full-time job at camp is to help with these procedures.

Drop off

We will perform a health screening and check temperatures for all participants before departing for camp.

The following health screening questions will be asked of all participants (campers, chaperones, staff):

- Have you been in meaningful contact with anyone that has COVID-19 in the past two weeks?
- Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?

If any health screen questions are answered with a yes or they present with a temperature of 100.4 or greater they are not allowed to come to camp.

Ongoing Monitoring

We will check temperatures daily (campers, chaperones, staff).

Campers that are sick will be separated and cared for by a staff member until they safely leave for home.

Promote Healthy Hygiene

We will educate on washing hands and covering coughs and sneezes.

We will have supplies throughout camp to support healthy hygiene behaviors, including soap, hand sanitizer, paper towels, and tissues.

We will require hand sanitizer for everyone entering the dining hall.

We will clean, sanitize, and disinfect common areas (For example, game equipment, tables & chairs, worship room, dining hall and door handles) multiple times per day.

Dining Safety Actions

We have more people serving on our cook staff in order to serve plates (no self-serve).

Snacks will be in individually wrapped packaging.
