COMMUNION

Have you ever considered the chaos surrounding the calm of the first Communion?

The religious and political leaders were plotting to kill Jesus, and one of His closest friends joined their forces. Knowing what was to come, Jesus sought to prepare the disciples for His death while readying Himself for the most significant sacrifice the world would ever witness.

Jesus faced external conflict and internal turmoil in the moments leading up to the cross. And yet, He reclined at the table with His disciples. He paused.

When we follow Jesus's example of Communion today, we have the opportunity to focus on the crux of the matter— Christ's body broken for us, Christ's blood poured out for us. Our external challenges and internal conflicts can wait. It's at Communion that we meditate on Peace, incarnate. We follow Jesus's instructions to remember His sacrifice, and we share this significant sacrament as the Church.
